"Kodrat Gesang"



Linggoasri Village is a village located in Kajen District, Pekalongan Regency. The northern border of Linggoasri Village is Pekiringan Ageng Village, the eastern border is Brengkolan Village, the southern border is Tenogo Village, and the western border is Kutorojo Village. The location is quite high so the temperature in this village is quite low. In education field, this village has 3 early childhood schools, 1 kindergarten and 2 elementary schools. These schools are Pratama Widya Pasraman "Saraswati", Pos Paud Anggrek, KB. Dadi Mulia, Satu Atap Kindergarten, Linggoasri Elementary Schol O1, and Linggoasri Elementary School 2.





Overall, Linggoasri Village is like a miniature of Indonesia with all its diversity. This can be seen from the fact that there are people from across religions here. Of the 5 hamlets consisting of Bojonglarang, Sadang, Linggo, Yosorejo, and Rejosari hamlets, there are 4 religions observed by the residents. They are Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism and Catholicism.



Based on the research and community service data conducted by UIN K.H. Abdurrahman Wahid Pekalongan, with a total population of 2015 people and from four different religions, there are 250 Hindus, 1,762 Muslims, 2 Buddhists and 1 Catholic living in Linggoasri.



Since 2022, this village has received assistance and empowerment programs based on religious moderation from UIN K.H. Abdurrahman Wahid and on March 10 2023 it was recognized as A Village with Interfaith Unity Awareness through a Decree by The Central Java Regional Office of Ministry of Religious Affairs, Number 393 of 2023. On June 7 2023 it was recognized as a Religious Moderation Village through the decision of Pekalongan Regency's Ministry of Religious Affairs Head Number 137 of 2023.





The Village Government realize that Harmony Village Management accommodate people with cross religion in religious and cultural moments. The Village Government aware of the Harmony Village Management and all elements of society in Linggoasri Village will work together to help each other in carrying out religious rituals and cultural activities, such as the birthday of the Prophet Muhammad SAW. However, non-Muslim youth were also involved to help manage the event.



Linggoasri Village has 2 types of place to pray; Mosque and temple. There are 5 mosques in Linggoasri, namely the Husnul Khatimah Mosque, At-Taqwa Mosque, Al-Barokah Mosque, Nurul Iman Mosque, and Baitul Muttaqien Mosque. There are 2 temples in Linggoasri Village, namely Kalingga Satya Dharma Temple and Tamansari Giri Yasa Temple.

Apart from that, there is no religious barrier in the lives and homes of Linggoasri residents. We can often find that in one family/one house there are family members following different religions, such as Muslims and Hindus, Hindus and Buddhists, Buddhists and Muslims, or Catholics and Muslims who live under one roof. The public cemetery in this village also has interfaith aspects where the coffins are contributions from all 4 religions. The coffin covers is provided by the Muslim community and the burial gravesare given by the Hindus. When a Hindu in Linggoasri passed away, they are not burned but buried facing the East. Catholics and Buddhists are also buried in the same public cemetery. You can watch it in full in the Documentary Film entitled Kodrat Gesang.

"Structurural Equality

Religious activities of all religions are facilitated by the Linggoasri village government. Even the Linggoasri village management structure, the village head is Muslim and the village secretary is Hindu. The management of the village that is aware of harmony and the village of religious moderation also consists of various religious figures. Linggoasri also has a symbol of the village, the panther. It does not highlight any particular religious characteristics.

"Social Activities, Nationalities and Cultural Tradition"

In addition, this village also has interfaith social activities, namely Orphan Compensation When Mukharoman is given compensation, not only Muslim orphans but Hindu orphans are also given compensation. Social Services in order to celebrate the Nyepi holiday are also donated not only hindu residents who are in need, but Islamic residents.

Community development activities to maintain harmony are also carried out by conducting Religious Moderation and Harmony Awareness Socialization and tolerance movement activities in houses of worship.

Interfaith environmental and house of worship mutual cooperation activities are also carried out in this village, when cleaning mosques or temples are carried out together in mutual cooperation with both Muslim and Hinduresidents.

Relation and social interaction





Participation in non-ritual religious commemoration activities across religions is also very good, for example in the ogoh-ogoh procession during nyepi IRMA (Ikatan Remaja Masjid) / (Muslim youth volunteers) helped secure and regulate traffic during the event and residents mingled following the procession. Conversely, in the syawalan and mukharoman events, Hindu youth (Peradah) also helped Muslim residents both in making gunungan and securing events and regulating traffic.





The tradition of sharing food and visiting each other during religious holidays is also carried out by the Linggoasri people. Even though they have different religions, during Idul Fitri (Islam) or Silakrama (1 week after Nyepi) they visit each other and share food, this happens because they come from one lineage, namely Kyai Singo Menggolo and Mbah Cokro Menggolo.

Moreover, in this village there are also public spaces that can be used across religions, namely the Village Hall, Pratama Widya Pasraman Saraswati Hall, Linggoasri Village Field, Hall and Linggoasri Camping G round.

There are also national symbols in Linggoasri, Village Halls, destionations, and all schools, where there are red and white flag poles and the symbol of the country, the Garuda bird, is installed. Apart from that, the designer also has moderated sign / information / prohibition as a result of an agreement on the roles that will be carried out by the strategic elite and residents of Linggo Asri Village in forming a village of moderation and awareness of harmony. The agreement is framed, posted in the village hall, and also socialized to all village residents.
